Sensor Cleaning

Just a reminder that Shawn Plouffe will be coming the night of the banquet, Dec 5th, to do sensor cleaning.

He is still only charging \$35. It's a great deal.

Shawn will be at the club by 6pm.

If you are bringing your camera in, please make sure that you have a fully charged battery.

NOTE:

For those of us who are unfamiliar with "sensor dust", I have copied a link that explains it, and how to test for it. That will help you decide if your sensor does need cleaning.

If you have a DSLR, and change lens, shoot in less than clean conditions, you probably have some dust.

If you notice "small spots" on you image, in the same place, all the time, you have dust.

It is more noticeable when you stop down your F stops..f10-f22 for example.

At f2.8- f8, etc. it probably won't be noticeable on the image.

Note, if you do have spots, it is easily corrected in Photoshop using content aware, etc., but if you have a lot of spots, it is a pain to fix them each time.

Help Setting Up

It takes an hour or less, depending on how fast we move, or how chatty we get. For all of these past years, there has just been a few of us who do it each time. We need more members so we can spread out the work load.
