- Images may be **adjusted (manipulated)**.
- Image Files shall be in the **same format as for digital competitions (maximum of 1400 pixels wide by maximum 1050 pixels tall)**.
- Image Files shall be **jpg** type files.
- Please submit completed images using the **club's web page by selecting the "Competitions" pulldown followed by "Scavenger Hunt" pulldown on or before March 17, 2021**
- Image File Names are **automatically created** by the submission app on the club web site.
- If at **least 6 members in a Digital class ("B", "A" or "AA")** enter in **9 or more Subjects each** then an additional Class Based competition will be created for that Class. These entrants would be **part of both a Class Based Scavenger Hunt and the Main Scavenger Hunt.**

Scoring:

- Zero points if the Digital Image does not satisfy subject.
- Four (4) points if the Digital Image is below average.
- Five (5) points if the Digital Image is average.
- Six (6) points if the Digital Image is above average.
- One can choose to skip one Subject because a person's lowest scored Image will be dropped.**
- Person with the highest total score wins.

3. Submission: Upload and submit up to 4 images (these can be changed at any time and any number of times till the March 28th, 2021 deadline).
