Assabet Valley Camera Club Starts 35th Season

Assabet Valley Camera Club, now going into its thirty-fifth year as a Hudson-based photography organization, meets the 1st. and 3rd. Wednesday of the month from September through early June. In 1985 a small group of people, who took an evening photography course at Assabet Valley Regional Vocational High School, decided to form the camera club. Currently AVCC has over 50 members of all ages, with both amateur and professional experience, from 15 different communities in the greater Metro West area.

Due to Covid 19 all AVCC meetings are currently being held online. At this club year's first meeting on Wednesday, September 2nd the evening's program will feature a "Members' Showcase", where individuals will briefly present their photographic images based on a theme or highlights of their summer experiences.

Normally, AVCC meetings are held in the Great Room at the Hudson Senior Center, 29 Church Street, Hudson, and officially begin at 7:30 PM. The first meeting of the month generally features a program designed to instruct and/or to entertain camera enthusiasts. During the second monthly meeting, member competitions of both print and digital images are judged and critiqued by qualified individuals. Assabet Valley Camera Club, a member of both the New England Camera Club Council and the Photographic Society of America, also participates in interclub competitions on regional, national and international levels.

AVCC welcomes anyone interested in learning more about photography as a visual art and its practical application as a science. Members benefit from the hands-on experiences, from the knowledge presented in programs, and from having their work critiqued. Time is winding down to submit your images for our Sept 2nd members program. I need your images by this coming Sunday so that I can prepare them. Your images do not have to be competition quality, just something that you want to share. What you did this summer, etc. or anything that you would like to show.

We are trying to keep it at 5 minutes per member. So a ball park figure for images would be between 60-75 images if you want to go the full 5 minutes with a slide show.

60 images @ 5 seconds each would be 5 minutes.

75 images @ 4 seconds each: 5 minutes.

If you are doing a narrative it will most likely be less.

To make it very simple, you do not need to put them into a slide show like Pro show, power point, or whatever else is out there. If you do not feel the need, or have the time to create a show, with music, etc. just send the images along to me, and we will just play them as a slide show. I can add some back ground music to it easily. We can also manually step through the images if you would like to do a narrative on them.

It is very simple to use. Place your images into a folder that you can find, then Click on the link and follow the prompts.

After you click on the link, click on "choose folders"

Then select your folder.

Then click on “upload”

Then click once again on “upload”

If you choose to make your own slide show do not use fancy transitions between images, they will not display smoothly using Zoom. Just use “no transitions”. If you are using Pro show, you also need to leave in the option menu “Playback in Full Screen” unchecked. If you have any questions, or need some help, please let John know.

Note: If you are reluctant to use Zoom because you are bashful to be seen on video, you can join the Zoom meeting without turning on your video.

You should be able to log easily on Zoom using a laptop that typically has a mic and speakers. You can do the same with a smartphone or Ipad.

If you have a desktop that has speakers and mic you are all set.

If you only have a desktop without a mic or speakers you can:

1. Use the desktop to access the video, and use your phone to call one of the dial in #'s listed in the link info for the audio portion. You will see and hear the meeting, but others will not see you.
2. Add speakers, or use a headphone, and a webcam.
